Step 1: I chose to read _____ (name of book) _____ book by _____ (author) _____ for my book project.

Step 2: Summarize your book. Think about the parts of the plot...

Exposition: What did you learn about the characters and setting in the beginning of your book?

Conflict: What is the main problem in your story? Who does the problem affect?

Rising Action: What are two or three main details/events that happen in the beginning of your story?

Climax: What is the most exciting part or turning point in your story, where things change.

Falling Action: What are two or three main details/events that happen toward the end of your story.

Resolution: How does your story end? Is the conflict solved? Are questions answered.

Use the following words to help you tell about the parts of the plot. (First, Next, Then, Last, Finally.)

Step 3: Choose a passage (one page) and read it word for word, then explain its importance. The passage should illustrate something important to the story.

After reading your passage, explain why you chose it and why it is important. Could you connect to the story? What stood out to you with passage?

Step 4: What is the theme or lesson that you think the author wants you to take away from reading this book?

Step 5: Recommendation: Make a recommendation to your classmates about this book. Who might enjoy it the most? Why?
