Slide 1

- Name of Book, Author, and your name.

Slide 2: Main Character

- Find a picture of what your main character might look like.
- Write two quotes from the book that describe the appearance of your main character. Include the page number for each quote.

Slide 3: Main Character

- Write about how the main character changed throughout the book (thoughts and feelings). Include what the character was like at the beginning and end of the book. What was responsible for this change in the character?

Slide 4: I-pod

- Write 3 -4 songs (and the artists) that you think the main character would have on his or her playlist. These should be real songs.
- Explain why your character would listen to each song.

Slide 5: Setting

- Describe the main setting of the book.
- Explain what time period the book is set in and explain why you think this.
- Find a picture that shows something similar to what you visualized as the setting in your book.

Slide 6: Summary

- List the 5ws of your book using one word for each.
- Who
- What
- When
- Where
- Why

Slide 7: Summary

- Write a one to two paragraph summary of your book. Your summary should discuss the 5ws. Be sure to proofread your summary for spelling and proper grammar.

Slide 8: Problem and Resolution

- What was the problem in the story?
- What characters did the problem affect?
- How was the problem solved?
- Give a quote from the story that relates to the problem.

Slide 9: Problem and Resolution

- Did you think the problem was resolved in a satisfactory way?
- Why did you think it was a good resolution or what would you change about it?
- Include an alternative solution to the problem.

Slide 10: Making Connections

- Text-to-Text: How does this connection help you understand the book better?
- Text-to-Self: How does this connection help you understand the book better?
- Text-to-World: How does this connection help you understand the book better?

Slide 11: Vocabulary

- Write 5 new words that you learned as you were reading, the page number you found them on, the definition, and the part of speech.

Slide 12: Book Review

- Rate the book out of five stars and explain why you rated it the way you did.
- What did you like?
- What would you change?
- Did the beginning hook you?
- Was the ending satisfying?
- Would you read another book from this author?

Slide 13: Reflection

- Reflect on your learning throughout this project.
- What are you most proud of?
- What improvements could you make?
